Tenjam products are manufactured in the U.S.A.

Plastic Seating:

A) Product Material:

- 1) Average thickness of material to exceed .20" or greater.
- 2) Waterproof and rust proof.
- 3) Fully compounded color (not dry blended) with UV light stabilizer to increase longevity of color retention in direct sunlight applications.
- 4) Suitable for both indoor and year-round outdoor use.
- 5) 100% recyclable.
- 6) Products tested to 750 lbs. static load on the seating surfaces. Drift tested to 250 lbs, Dash & Swerve Benches tested to 1000 lbs, Twisted Hex tested to 250 lbs, Elevate Tiered Seating tested to 1000 lbs.
- 7) Rubber legs on hard plastic products are Santoprene material and are considered a non-warranty replacement item that are intended to wear as they provide floor protection in indoor and outdoor spaces.

B) Metal Frame Materials:

 Powder coated steel frames pass ASTM B117-16: No visual evidence of corrosion at the end of 1000 hours of exposure to salt spray corrosion testing. Performed in a salt spray chamber using a 5% +/-1% salt solution at 95°F +/-3°F.

C) Compact Laminate (a.k.a. Phenolic) Material:

- 1) All-weather performance in all climates. Impervious to moisture and bacteria.
- 2) Damaging UV rays a 99% filtered for longer color retention.
- 3) Zero edge banding.
- 4) Includes threaded inserts permanently installed into the material for easy assembly.
- D) Emissions: Session Series hard plastic seating is compliant with:
 - 1) ANSI/BIFMA X7.1-2011 7-day emission limits for seating.
 - 2) ANSI/BIFMA e3-2014 Furniture Sustainability Standard Sections 7.6.1, 7.6.2, and 7.6.3 for seating.
 - 3) LEED v4 EQ Credit: Low-Emitting Materials for Interior Design and Construction applicable to Commercial Interiors, Retail, and Hospitality criteria by virtue of compliance with ANSI/BIFMA e3-2014 Section 7.6.1 and



7.6.2

- 4) LEED v4 EQ Credit: Low-Emitting Materials for Building Design and Construction applicable to New Construction, Core and Shell, Schools, Retail, Data Centers, Warehouses and Distribution Centers, Healthcare, and Hospitality criteria by virtue of compliance with ANSI/BIFMA e3-2014 Sections 7.6.1 and 7.6.2
- 5) The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Standard Method Version 1.1 (2010) Freestanding Furniture criteria for open-plan office workstation storage components.
- 6) All Session products may be eligible for ANSI/BIFMA e3 and LEED credits.
- 7) "MAS Certified Green" for low-emitting materials.
- E) Fire Testing
 - 1) Compliant with California Technical Bulletin 117-2013.

 - 1) One-Piece Hard Plastic Seating = 5 Year Limited Warranty
 - 2) Tables = 3 Year Limited Warranty
 - 3) Plastic Seating With Metal Framés = 3 Year Limited Warranty
 - 4) Flexible Plastic Seating (a.k.a. DuraFLEX Series) = 3 Year Limited Warranty
 - 5) Waterproof Cushions = 1 Year Limited Warranty
 - 6) Clean with Dawn® dish soap and water, Formula 409®, Fantastik®, Windex®, and Scrubbing Bubbles®. Disinfect Bleach 1:9 ratio of bleach to water, Dispatch® 1:10 dilution, hydrogen peroxide, CaviWipes®, BioWipes®, Coverage Plus Germicidal Wipes®, Glance NA® Diluted 1:50
