## IN-POOL LOUNGE CHAIR

### SPLASH Series

The most comfortable in-pool chair is here. Take a seat in the Woosah Chair and let your Shoulders and Arms Relax. Now take a deep breath and say "Wooooo-saaaaah" while slowly exhaling. Repeat until you feel the tension wash away.

The ergonomic contouring of the seat makes for a very comfortable chair. The seat is made with soft contoured, rotationally molded polyethylene that can withstand sun, rain, snow, ice and pool chemicals.

Woosah Chair is available in both a 'Short' and 'Tall' configuration to accommodate different water depths.

- Two heights available for the base.
- Designed for in-pool use and has zero metal components.
- Great ergonomic seat profile and tall backrest.
- Supports up to 350 lbs
- Easy to add to the pool and easy to remove from the pool. No screw plugs to deal with.
- Leg bases are rounded for use in all types of pools, including vinyl liner.

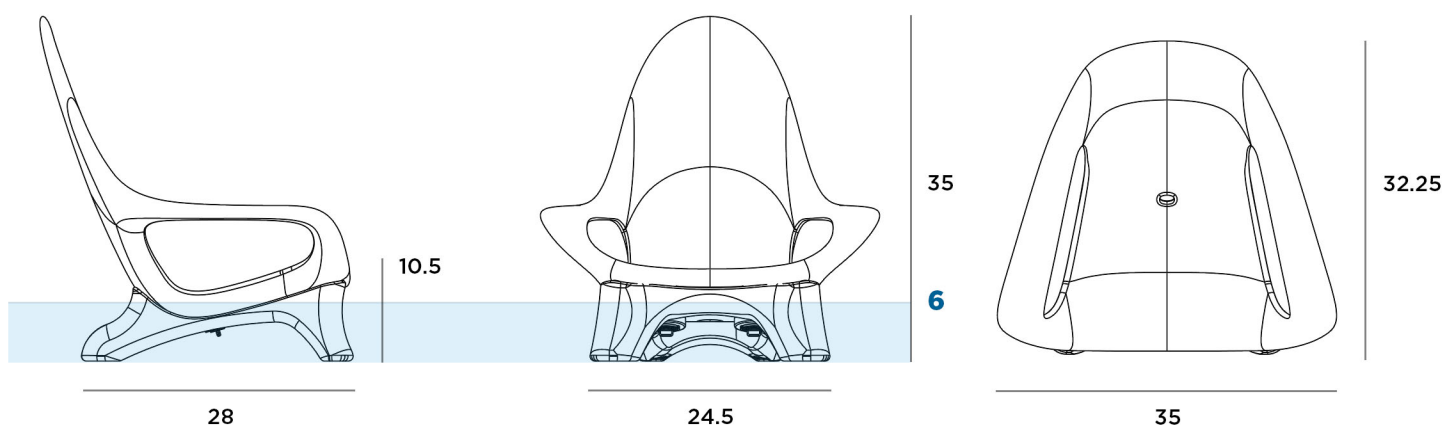

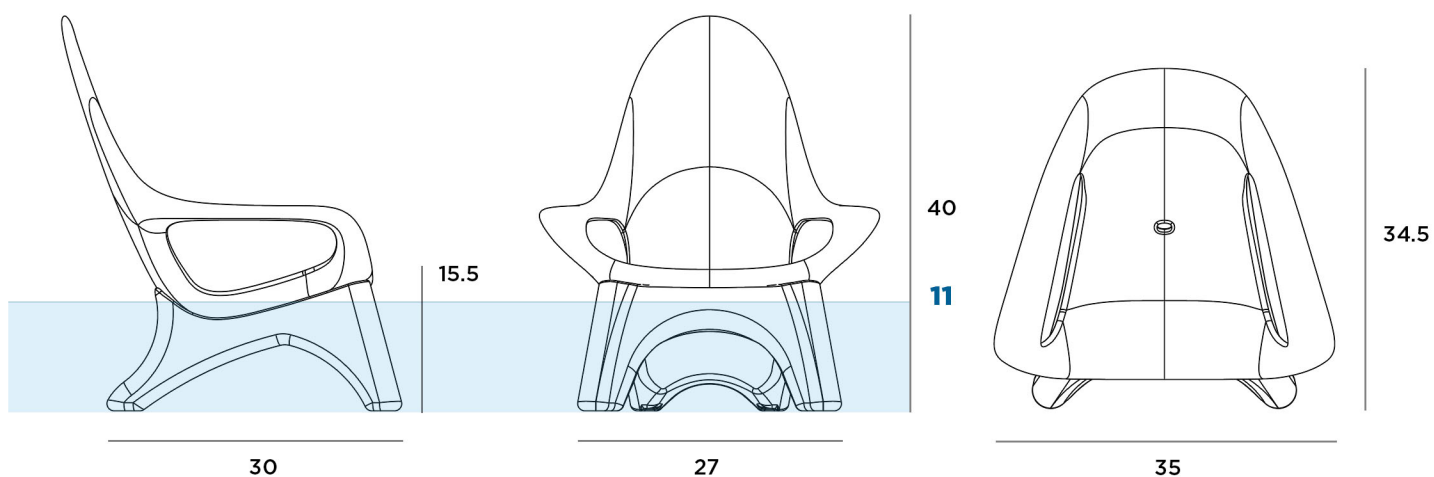
## WOOSAH (SHORT BASE)

Choose the Short base if you have pool water depth under 6" or if you want to sit lower and have more of your body submerged in water depths above 6". If you have a sun shelf with water depth of 6" or less you'll be able to leave this chair in the pool and it will resist movement from light waves or wind. If you have water depth over 6" you can still use this chair in your pool, but when you are not sitting in the chair it will move or float as the water depth increases above 6". The chair is easy to place into your pool and remove from the pool and use on your patio. However, the Short version will feel really low when used on the patio and will be more difficult to enter and exit the seat.



## WOOSAH (TALL BASE)

Choose the Tall base for a normal "Adirondack" seating height for optimal comfort in the pool or on the patio. If you have a sun shelf with water depth of 11" or less you'll be able to leave this chair in the pool and it will resist movement from light waves or wind. If you have water depth over 11" you can still use this chair in your pool, but when you are not sitting in the chair it will move or float as the water depth increases above 11". The chair is easy to place into your pool and remove from the pool and use on your patio.

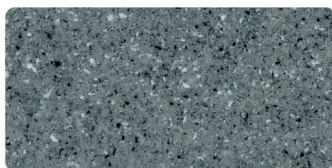

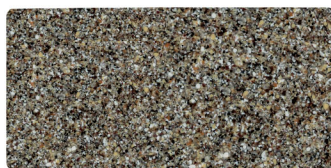

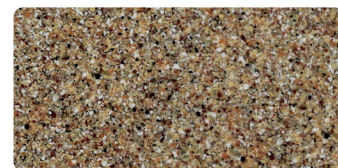
**White Granite (WG)**

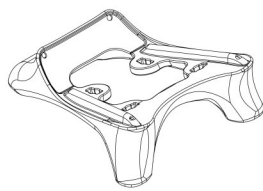

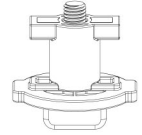
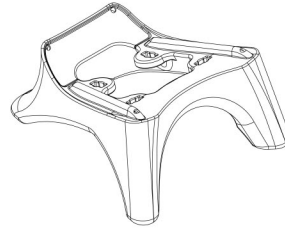
## INCLUDED PARTS



Seat



Base (Short or Tall)



Connector (x4)

Easy assembly. No tools required.

### Step 1

Spread out a towel or moving blanket. You can also cut the sides of the box so the box spreads out flat on the ground. This is to protect the seat and the base from scratching during assembly.

### Step 2

Place the plastic seat upside down on the towel or blanket so the bottom of the chair is facing towards you.

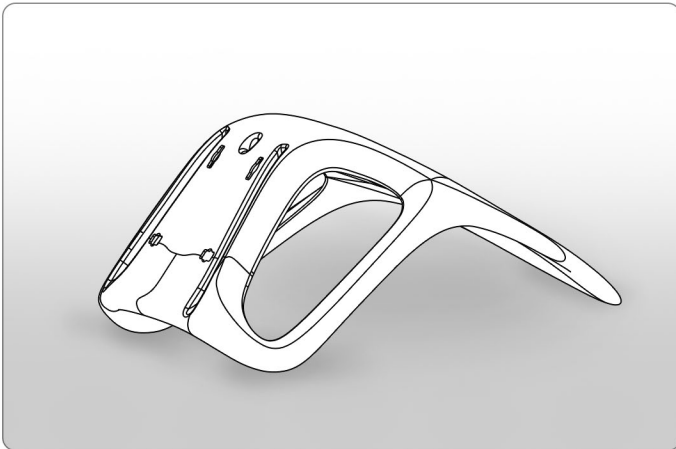

### Step 3

Turn the connector screw knob counter clockwise to expand each connector. Align the raised ridges on the base with the channels on the bottom of the seat. Hold the pieces together while inserting all 4 connectors through base and into the bottom of the seat. You'll see the "key holes" aligned that accept the head of the connector.

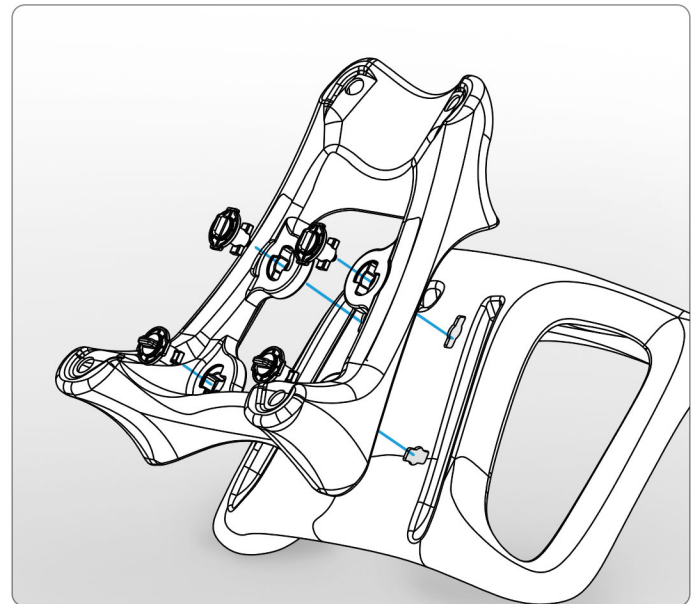

### Step 4

Turn the outer ring of each connector to the right (clockwise) 90 degrees. Hold this outer ring at the 90 degree position while twisting the head of the center plastic screw until it is securely tightened by hand. Do not use a pliers or tools to turn the connectors. Hand tightening is enough and assembly is complete.
